"I had given up on myself."

My parents divorced when I was three,"
Nichole remembers. "So, my sister
and younger brother and I
grew up with a single dad, which
was uncommon then. We didn't
go to church, but a neighbor did
a little Bible study for kids in the
neighborhood. I asked God into my
heart when I was a kid."

Nichole graduated from high school, worked at several jobs, and then met the man who eventually introduced her to drugs.

"I struggled with a meth addiction for five years," she says. "I became homeless, and I kind of gave up on myself." In her desperation, she committed a felony and was jailed for six months.

"I had a spiritual experience when I was in jail. I was in solitary confinement, and I had a lot of time to reflect on my life and what I wanted moving forward. It was mostly affirmation from God after I had felt so low. I talked with him every day, and I really feel like my time in jail was his way of protecting me."
